



KDBC Covid Safety Plan v.3

WA has the following restrictions in place that are relevant to KDBC.

Check in – contact registers

If KDBC is asked to produce a contact register of people attending the KDBC premises by the WA Government we are required to do so within 3 hours.

The KDBC computer-based results record for bridge sessions held on Monday am, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday pm each week will be used as the basis for the contact register at these times. The list will be compiled by a Management Committee (MC) member who will add members' telephone contact numbers to the bridge session record.

At any time, people may attend the KDBC premises and not participate in these 4 bridge sessions. In these cases, members must register using the SafeWA QRS signs OR complete the manual contact register that will be available in the foyer. Either of these methods must be used, for example, for the Monday evening mentored bridge session, MC, and sub-committee meetings.

The WA Government's [SafeWA](#) app is a way for people to easily check-in –sometimes at KDBC this will work, at other times it won't because of the bad internet connection available from the club premises. The details about the wired internet connection owned by KDBC are available for members to use – it provides the best internet connection while at the club for contact registration using SafeWA. Members should attempt to record their attendance if they have the SafeWA application on their phones. If it does not work, or they don't use that application, they must complete an entry on the manual written contact register.

When completing the manual written Contact register members must provide their name and their contact phone number.

Social Distancing and Physical Distancing

2 Square (2sqm)meter rule

The 2sqm rule determines the number of people we can seat in KDBC rooms.

This means that 60 people, or 15 tables of four people, is the maximum number of people we can have at any bridge session.

Western Australians are still advised to stay 1.5 metres away from other people whenever and wherever we can. However, KDBC cannot ensure that members will be 1.5 metres apart when playing at the bridge tables and moving about the room during play.

For these reasons we have decided that KDBC bridge sessions are restricted to members only

In other areas inside the club premises members should choose to maintain 1.5 metres social distancing. To facilitate this: if any member requests another member to move away to fit with the 1.5 sqm limit, they must comply.

Hygiene

- Members must use hand sanitiser as they enter the premises AND before they make tea or coffee.
- Hand sanitiser will be available at each table.
- Players should sit back from the table to maximise social distancing.
- KDBC cups may be used. All cups and glasses must be washed in our dishwasher.
- Food or drinks may be consumed in the playing room however, before bridge commences or recommences, all debris, coffee cups and disposable cups must be removed from the playing area
- Members should bring the exact amount of table money (\$6) or use tokens for payment to minimise handling of cash. Change, or credit, will not be given.
- Only the Directors will manage the air conditioners.
- The Director will maximise the amount of fresh air in the room by opening windows.
- Please ensure you wash your hands thoroughly, using soap or hand sanitiser, after using the toilet.

Members must not come to KDBC if they are feeling even slightly unwell – especially if they have a temperature and any cold or flu symptoms.

- Any player who is not feeling well or is unable to control a cough or has a high temperature, should not attend the club. Members should seek to be tested for Covid-19 if they have any respiratory symptoms.
- If a member coughs or sneezes they should do so into their elbow or into a tissue which should then be disposed of in the bins in the playing room. Hands should be sanitised afterwards, especially as we then touch cards which are shared with other members playing that day.
- The MC encourages all members to get their Covid and Flu vaccinations as soon as possible.
